

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the current level of state funding is inadequate to properly provide for the education of persons of school age residing within the district's boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors deems it necessary and in the best interest of the school district to supplement the revenue available to the General Fund of **DAMMAN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 7** in order to provide funds necessary to meet expenses attributable to the General Fund. These expenses include, but are not limited to, the following: salaries and wages, contract services with neighboring district, books, supplies, utility and maintenance costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions hereinabove set forth require the holding of a special election in the district; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors of **DAMMAN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 7, Kittitas County, Washington**, as follows:

1. That a special election be held **by mail** in the aforesaid school district on February 14, 2012, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of said school district, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

**PROPOSITION - GENERAL OPERATING EXPENSES LEVY:**

Shall a tax levy of \$210,000, the estimated amount required to produce such being \$2.170478 per \$1,000 assessed valuation in excess of the maximum tax levy provided by law for school districts without a vote of the electors, be made in 2012 for collection in 2013, and \$225,000, the estimated amount required to produce such being \$2.325512 per \$1,000 assessed valuation in excess of the maximum tax levy provided by law for school districts without a vote of the electors, be made in 2013 for collection in 2014, upon all taxable property of **DAMMAN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 7, Kittitas County, Washington**, for the General Fund of the District.

2. That the proceeds of the aforesaid tax levy be used either with or without additional funds now available or hereafter available for the purposes hereinabove stated.

3. That the Kittitas County Auditor, as ex-officio Supervisor of Elections, be and is hereby requested to call a special election for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the district the proposition hereinabove set forth and the secretary to the Board is directed to transmit to the Kittitas County Auditor a certified copy of this resolution at least forty-five (45) days prior to the proposed election date in order that the said Auditor may perform such duties as are necessary and/or required by law, to the end that the question of whether or not the special levy shall be assessed as hereinafter provided, shall be submitted to the voters of the school district at

the aforesaid special school election, **by mail**, including the selection of necessary election officials, if any, to conduct such election, and publication of the notice of special election as required by law.

4. That the ballot title shall be drawn by the Prosecuting Attorney of Kittitas County, Washington, beneath which shall be provided:
