ADMINISTRATIVE APPEAL      CHEPODA/JOHNSON SEGREGATION APPEAL      CDS

At 1:30 p.m. **CHAIRMAN GOLLADAY** opened the Chepoda/Johnson Testamentary Segregation Appeal Hearing.

**DAVID TAYLOR, COMMUNITY SERVICES DIRECTOR** acknowledged a letter from the appellant's attorney requesting the hearing to be continued due to scheduling issues. Mr. Taylor said staff did not have a problem rescheduling the hearing because it is important to have the appellants present. **JIM HURSON DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY** said he had spoke with Darrell Ellis the appellant's attorney about continuing the hearing and he didn't have any problems with it. **COMMISSIONER HUSTON** asked what the appeal entailed. **MR TAYLOR** explained that it is an appeal of an Administrative Decision of a Testamentary Segregation. The denial was based upon the Deputy Prosecutor's recommendation.
