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### STUDY SESSION MINUTES July 9, 2007

**HART ROAD:** Director Drexler presented a handout of the history of Hart Road. He went over the narrative and the logistics of the road. He also included a handout as to what the requirements are for a road to be on the Six-year Transportation Plan. Commissioner Crankovich stated that he is receiving calls from concerned citizens as to why Hart Road isn't on the plan and wanted support to answer them. Director Drexler stated that the current road system was adopted in the 1970's and that there are some easements that exist on Hart Road for the satellites that exist up there.


**LAMBERT ROAD ACCESS:** Director Drexler stated that he had received a letter from Lambert Road residents requesting the county address an issue of illegal access. There is a property owner that is not abiding by the "joint-use driveway" condition of the plat, and instead using an illegal second access off his property. Director Piercy stated that previously there was a barrier of some sort on this illegal access but has since been removed, Code Enforcement is investigating the issue.

**ELLENSBURG TRAP & SKEET CLUB:** Commission Bowen stated that Gar Hill (Trap & Skeet Rep.) had contacted him in regard to the lead removal at the airport and the possibility of a new lease. Mr. Hill stated that in order to apply for funding for their new site they need to show that they either have a lease for the property or are in the process of getting one. Kelly Carlson (DPW) stated that the Trap & Skeet has been informed that they would not receive a lease for the new site until the previous site had been cleaned up. There was more discussion on how we could work a new lease with contingencies in order to assist the Trap & Skeet in their funding application.

**Board Direction:** BOCC directed staff to set a public hearing to consider a lease with the Trap & Skeet Club and for staff to work with legal to include language that has strict contingencies in the lease pertaining to the lead clean up at the previous site.
