STUDY SESSION MINUTES

July 16, 2007

THOSE PRESENT: Alan Crankovich, Mark McClain, Allison Kimball (CDS), Brandon Drexler (DPW), Doug D'Hondt (DPW), Candie Leader (DPW)

JACK AND INDIAN CREEK CULVERT REPLACEMENT:

Anna Lael from the KC Conservation District was present to discuss the Jack and Indian Creek Culvert Replacement Projects. She presented copies of the grant application and stated that they are still in the pre-application stage and was hoping to have finalization on or around August 1, 2007. She stated that some contribution from the County was needed for the project. Ms. Lael stated that the projects were originally separate but they combined them with the Jack Creek culvert being the priority. Currently the culverts are barriers for the fish passage and the project is 97% for the fish and around 3% benefit for the County. Doug D'Hondt stated that at the present time the culverts are undersized and if there were to be flood issues we would see a situation similar to the Salmon La Sac flooding. The Forest Service is considering matching funds and would like the roads moved if possible. Commissioner McClain suggested the County contribute a total of \$20,000 for both culvert replacement projects from the Road Fund.

Board Direction: **\$20,000.00 total for both projects. Put on next Agenda for signatures needed by KC Conservation District.**


STORIE LANE: Commissioner Crankovich asked about the situation of there being construction on a lot but no access permit submitted. Director Drexler stated we can't stop any work on the lot itself.

Board Direction: **Get with Director Piercy from CDS to discuss further.**

NELSON DAIRY ROAD: Director Drexler mentioned that they are keeping Nelson Dairy Road watered for dust control. Commissioner Crankovich stated that a resident of the area would like stabilization to occur. Flaggers are sending drivers that route and there is also an increase of traffic on Shaft Street. Cle Elum Police Department is checking the speeds there since it is a 25mph zone.
