## **What is this all about?**

This is the second set of public workshops to share information about the County's current effort to revise the Comprehensive Plan to meet state requirements.

## **What's the purpose of the workshops?**

The County will present recommendations about whether county subareas—Vantage, Thorp, Ronald, Easton and Snoqualmie Pass—should develop at rural or urban densities. The County also will present recommendations about the Kittitas Urban Growth Area.

## **How will I be affected?**

If you live or own property in any of the five county subareas or the City of Kittitas, these recommendations could affect future new development or re-development allowed on your property.

## **How can I participate?**

Come to one of the four public workshops. Input received at the workshops and via our Web site will be presented to the Kittitas County Planning Commission and the Board of County Commissioners prior to a final decision.
