

## AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES

This Agreement is entered into by the Kittitas County Board of Commissioners and the Kittitas County Road Department ("County") and the Kittitas County Conservation District (KCCD).

The County shall pay an amount up to \$5,000.00, annually from the County Road Fund to the KCCD to implement and administer a cost sharing program for the use of Polyacrylamide (PAM) to reduce silt in the County road ditches.

The KCCD shall implement and administer the cost share program conforming to the attached PAM Cost Share Program. In addition, KCCD shall provide an end of the program report by March 30 of each year. This report shall contain information identifying the properties on which PAM was applied during the program and the road ditches, which receive run-off from these properties.

This Agreement is effective for 10 years and renews annually. It is neither expressed nor implied that funding will be provided by the County for the PAM program, other than that mentioned above.

Either party shall terminate this agreement with 60 days notice to the other party.


