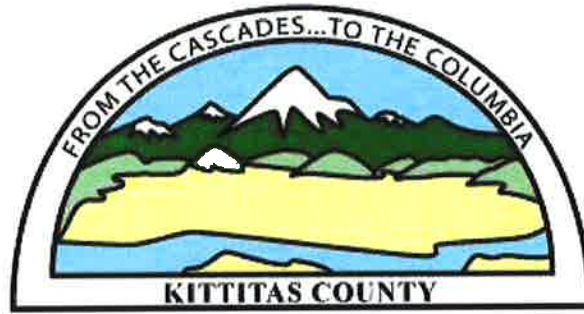


PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the responding agencies are committed to assisting the community in preparedness and resiliency training; and


