Seating

This event is similar to events such as Taste Washington but on a much smaller scale. We will have a few tables with chairs set up on our patio for people to sit at and enjoy the atmosphere but the idea is that people will go from booth to booth sampling the food and beverages while being educated on the sampling.

Food & Beverage

Swiftwater Cellars will be serving various foods that will be prepared onsite in our cooking facilities as covered under our Kittitas County Public Health Department "General food services food level 3/ Supplemental Catering" Permit. The permit number is FE-13-00061 and is valid through October 31, 2014. The food vendors that participate in the event will have small bites prepared at there facilities then brought to the event. Everyone working in the booths are required to have valid food handler's permits and alcohol serving permits. All Swiftwater Cellars staff that will be handling food will have valid food handler's permits. Beer, wine, and hard alcohol will be available during the event at the booths only. Swiftwater Cellars staff will be on hand to check IDs for all patrons who will be consuming alcohol and staff will also be roaming the venue looking for any alcohol consumption violations that may occur. We are expecting around 50 vendors at the event.

Bathroom Facilities

Currently, the outdoor amphitheater at Swiftwater Cellars has 8 fixed restroom units which will be used solely for the Wine in the Pines event. Patrons will also be able to go into the main area of the winery and use the other 16 bathroom units that the facility has. Patrons will not need to walk more than 200 feet to reach a the designated restrooms from anywhere inside the venue.

Security

Swiftwater Cellars staff will be providing security for the event. We anticipate have 5 staff members onsite for security during the event to keep patrons safe and assist in controlling human traffic in an orderly fashion. Leena Haija will be the event manager at Wine in the Pines.. There will also be an additional 5-10 Swiftwater Cellars staff members onsite handling various functions for the event.

EMS Services

We have an agreement with Fire District 7 and their facility located on Suncadia property will be able to handle any EMS needs that may arise during the event.

Traffic Control

The event will utilize the onsite parking at Swiftwater Cellars with no offsite parking maintained by the venue. Handicap access parking spots will be maintained at the event venue for patrons displaying a state certified placard.

Offsite Parking

Any patrons staying at the Suncadia Lodge will be encouraged to park there and take the Suncadia shuttle to the venue.

Garbage/Recycling

We have a contract with Waste Management of Ellensburg and they will bring additional dumpsters to our location to handle the increased amount of garbage produced by the event. We will also have the proper recycling receptacles placed next to each garbage can to reduce the amount of trash produced by the event.


