ACTION REQUESTED:

Recommend approval to implement changes in the water availability requirements for preliminary and final plat approval and distribution of letter to Kittitas County land developers.

BACKGROUND:

Kittitas County Public Health Department was asked to review the water availability for platting requirements by the BOCC in September of 2009 based on a complaint raised by a developer. The Prosecutor reviewed state and county code and recommendations were presented during several study sessions during October - November 2009 and January - March 2010.

INTERACTION:

The Board of County Commissioners reviewed the proposed water availability for preliminary and final plat approval process during study sessions occurring October - November 2009 and January - March 2010. Deputy Prosecutor Brent Bottoms provided recommendations for water availability requirements for preliminary and final plat approval.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the recommended water availability requirements for preliminary and final plat approval and distribution of written correspondence to Kittitas County land developers.
