RESOLUTION NO. 2012- 153

A Resolution Authorizing Execution of Interlocal Agreement with King County

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, provides the capability for public agencies to cooperate by providing services and facilities for mutual advantage; and

WHEREAS, KING COUNTY and KITTITAS COUNTY are authorized to plan for and manage municipal solid waste generated and collected within their unincorporated jurisdiction pursuant to state and local laws, including Chapters 70.95 and 36.58 RCW, the Kittitas County Code and the King County Code, and through their Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plans (CSWMP) prepared in accordance with RCW 70.95.080; and

WHEREAS, As part of their solid waste handling responsibilities, KING COUNTY and KITTITAS COUNTY have entered into Solid Waste Interlocal Agreements with the majority of the cities located within their respective jurisdictions through which the counties have designated specific solid waste transfer and disposal sites within their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Historically solid waste generated and collected within the Snoqualmie Pass Rural Town, which is located in unincorporated King County has been disposed in Kittitas County; and

WHEREAS, Both Counties would like to continue that collection process; and

WHEREAS, KING COUNTY and KITTITAS COUNTY possess authority to enter into this Agreement pursuant to Chapter 39.34 RCW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That the attached Interlocal Agreement between Kittitas County and King County be executed for the collection of solid waste within the Snoqualmie Pass Rural Town.
