WHEREAS, RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, provides the capability for public agencies to cooperate by providing services and facilities for mutual advantage; and

WHEREAS, Kittitas County, through the Kittitas County Public Health Department, is charged with informing the public as to the causes, nature, and prevention of disease and disability and the preservation, promotion, and improvement of health, in part through promoting and participation in the establishment of health educational or training activities; and

WHEREAS, The powers and duties of the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department include the ability to contract for provision of online food worker training, testing, and card issuance; and

WHEREAS, The Kittitas County Public Health Department and the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department wish to contract to provide online food worker training, testing and card issuance to promote and protect the health, safety, and well-being of the public and prevent the spread of disease by food; and

WHEREAS, All parties have agreed to enter into such an agreement under the terms and conditions of the Interlocal Agreement shown on and attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners authorized the execution of this Interagency Agreement by action taken at a regular meeting; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Kittitas County, Washington adopts the Interagency Agreement with the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department that is attached hereto, and incorporated herein by this reference.
