ACTION REQUESTED:

The Board of County Commissioners' authorizes the signature of the Public Health Administrator on the MOU between Grant County and Kittitas County Public Health to establish a working partnership to participate in the Washington State Department of Health- Healthy Communities Obesity, Diabetes Heart Disease and Stroke Prevention Program. Kittitas County will participate on a voluntary basis with additional counties in the North Central Region established to support collaborative effort to improve the health of people throughout the geographic area.

BACKGROUND:

In the fall of 2014, the DOH announced a funding opportunity for up to six communities to implement the Healthy Communities Obesity, Diabetes, Heart Disease and Stroke Prevention Program. There will be one lead organization in each community that will develop and implement a component-specific work plan focused on selected activities. The work plan will align with the requirement of the CDC grant, State and Local and Public Health Actions to Prevent Obesity, Diabetes, Heart Disease and Stroke financed solely by 2014 Prevention and Public Health Funds.
