ACTION REQUESTED:

Consider the attached resolution recinding/repealing Resolution 2004-36 and instructing Kittitas County Environmental Health to require whatever information they need from applicants when state law requires a determination regarding potable water.

BACKGROUND:

Prior to 2004, Kittitas County required wells to be dug and water tested before a plat would obtain final approval. Resolution 2004-36 placed limits on the information that applicants provided. This creates difficulties in making the determinations required of the County by State law, both Chapters 58.17 and 19.27 RCW. Several public meetings regarding the old policy that Reolution 2004-36 have occured and the administrative policy and practice has been modified.
