AGENDA DATE: August 4, 2015

ACTION REQUESTED: Request to Approve a Resolution Eliminating Probation Services as a Single Department and Instituting the Misdemeanant Probation and Juvenile Court Services Departments

BACKGROUND: On May 5, 2014, Probation Director met with BOCC at a Department Head meeting to discuss succession planning pending current director's retirement. On July 28, 2014, at another BOCC Department Head meeting, issues including separation of the departments within Probation Services were reviewed with a Probation Services Succession Planning Document offered for consideration. The BOCC wanted a review with the Judges. On August 25, 2014, the Kittitas County Trial Court Coordination Council met where restructuring of the Probation Services Department was reviewed and the Judges directed a study session be set with the Board of County Commissioners. On September 3, 2014, the BOCC met with the Presiding Judges of the Superior, Upper and Lower District Courts and Probation Director to review issues relative to pending changes. A legal review by the Kittitas County Prosecuting Attorney's office was provided for the Presiding Judges and a draft Resolution subsequently provided to effect the discussed change of separation to two departments.

INTERACTION: The Prosecutors office created and signed the proposed Resolution. The Presiding Judges were again apprised of the Resolutions intent.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve a Resolution Eliminating Probation Services as a Single Department and Instituting the Misdemeanant Probation and Juvenile Court Services Departments, effective September 2, 2015.
