ACTION REQUESTED: Set a public hearing to take place on December 1,

2015 to consider adopting the Yakima River

Corridor Plan.

BACKGROUND: The Yakima River Corridor Plan was completed in

September 2015. The plan, funded by the Flood Control Zone District and the Salmon Recovery Funding Board, assessed the reach of the Yakima River from Hansen Pits to Ringer Loop Road.

The plan was developed by consultants Watershed Science and Engineering and Hererra. A technical advisory committee and landowner committee were formed and met throughout the planning

process.

The plan identifies priority locations within the project reach for improvements to habitat and reduction in flood hazards. The final plan details the criteria and methodology used to determine the

priority projects.

Many grant applications require the applicant to demonstrate the project development has gone through a public process. In addition to the citizen

participation during the planning process, adoption by the BOCC will help to demonstrate the

public process.
