Consider Enhanced 911 (E911) County Equipment

Contract for State FY2016/17 (July 1, 2015 - June 30,

2017), #E16-216

BACKGROUND: By RCW, enhanced 911 services are a county obligation, which Kittitas County delegated to KITTCOM. Two sources are used to fund the mandate; a local \$.70 per month per access line tax and grants from the State Enhanced 911 Program Office for WAC eligible services and equipment not fully funded by local E911 tax revenue.

RCW 38.52.540(1) provides that funds from the state E911 account should be used to support the statewide coordination and management of the enhanced 911 system.

The Equipment Contract will provide the needed funding for the purchase of the Next Generation 9-1-1 phone system and recorder as well as additional infrastructure needs to accommodate housing & use of the phone system & recorder. The full cost of the project is \$468,984.00.

INTERACTION: Contract E16-216 for E911 County Equipment is before the Board for consideration.

RECOMMENDATION: Authorize the Board Chairman to sign the Enhanced 911 contract with the Washington State Military Department.
