BACKGROUND:

The purpose of the Washington State Patrol Agreement is evidence that trafficking in controlled substances exists and that such illegal activity has a substantial and detrimental effect on the health and general welfare of the people in the State of Washington. The purpose of this Agreement is to provide funding to local law enforcement agencies to support the locating and eradication of illicit cannabis plants, and the investigation and prosecution of the cases involving controlled substances before state and federal courts in State of Washington.
