- A Resolution Authorizing Execution of an Interlocal Agreement Between Kittitas County and the Town of South Cle Elum Concerning Cost Sharing for Planning Studies

  Associated with the Comprehensive Plan Update and UGA Review
- WHEREAS, the Growth Management Act (GMA) requires the County and Cities/Towns to update their respective comprehensive plans and review and, if necessary, revise urban growth areas by June 30, 2017 (RCW 36.70A.130); and
- WHEREAS, cooperative relationships, joint review of growth management planning issues, and coordination between the County and Cities/Towns are mutually beneficial; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Town and County desire to share costs for planning and analyses associated with the urban growth area review that is due by 2017;
- WHEREAS, the Town and County agree to share consultant costs for countywide population projection and allocations; employment projections and allocations; and land capacity analysis that includes residential, commercial, and industrial land; and
- WHEREAS, the costs of determining countywide employment projections and allocations to urban growth areas, and the commercial and industrial land capacity analysis will be apportioned in accordance with the percentage of population in the respective incorporated city/town relative to the Washington State Office of Financial Management's 2015 population estimates for the incorporated population of Kittitas County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act chapter 39.34 RCW, between Kittitas County and the Town of South Cle Elum for cost sharing of planning studies associated with the Comprehensive Plan update and UGA Review is adopted and shall be forthwith filed with the Kittitas County Auditor pursuant to RCW 39.34.040.
