ACTION REQUESTED:

Request to approve Amendment of Interlocal Agreement between Kittitas County Noxious Weed Control Board and Iron Horse, Helen McCabe State Park.

BACKGROUND:

In 2009 State Parks signed an interlocal agreement with the Kittitas County Noxious Weed Control Board for undesirable plant surveys and weed control work at Helen McCabe and Iron Horse State Parks. This year State Parks has requested an amendment to the 2009 interlocal agreement that would extend the agreement for another year. This is the fourth year for such an agreement, which has been beneficial for weed control in Kittitas County, allowing the Weed Board to oversee weed control operations along these vectors of weed dispersal, and prescribe weed control operations on State Parks land that is satisfactory to both parties.

INTERACTION:

Washington State Parks has submitted an amendment to the 2009 interlocal agreement to the Weed Board for signature. Deputy Prosecutor Suzanne Becker has reviewed and approved the contract as form, The Auditor's Office has reviewed the contract, and the Kittitas County Noxious Weed Control Board has reviewed and approved the contract.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approval by the Kittitas County Board of County Commissioners of the amendment to the Interlocal Agreement 333-NW-625-1 between Kittitas County Noxious Weed Control Board and Iron Horse, Helen McCabe State Park.
