BACKGROUND:

The Juvenile Accountability Block Grant is federal funding passed through the States, administered by the Juvenile Rehabilitation Administration for offender youth interventions by the Juvenile Courts of the State of Washington. This is an amendment to extend the original agreement into a fifth year, the current year for the dates noted above. We are providing the amended agreement document for signature of the Board Chairperson after receiving the Presiding Judge's signature. This is the twelfth year of this type agreement and the fifth year of this specific agreement with a total amount of \$50,580.00 having been allocated to the Kittitas County Juvenile Court. The total amount for this year includes a required match of \$1,175.56 which is covered by in kind services and staff salaries and benefits including administrative time. This agreement is identical in focus to the previous years and will provide the funding of the same program activities as approved in the previous year. Specifically these are ongoing efforts to develop and implement restorative justice programs in our community that includes a Summer Work Crew to provide supervised community restitution opportunities for youth as well as Healthy Choices Group activities. The third area of focus provides funding for urinalysis testing to monitor and intervene with youth who are abusing substances.

INTERACTION:

The agreement has been reviewed by the Prosecutor's office and approved as to form. The Auditor's office was advised of the grant.

RECOMMENDATION:

Board authorize the Chair's signature.
