#### Dear Board Members:

I am writing this memo as a representative for the American Cancer Society, Great West Division.

We are in the final preparation stages of our Climb to Conquer Cancer at Manastash Ridge. It has come to my attention that we were to have submitted our Special Event Application at least 60 days prior to our event.

The event is scheduled to take place at Manastash Ridge on Sunday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, from 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m.

I submitted our application, however, was unable to submit it as early as required by Kittitas County Code Chapter 5.20.020. This is due to some challenges in receiving all required information to complete the application. Our non-profit organization assists and supports community volunteers in the planning and implementation of our fundraising events throughout the year, in every State of the U.S. and in 20 other countries worldwide.

Unfortunately, since the major planning is coordinated by local volunteers, it does not always lead to a timely receipt of information that we need to fulfill requirements such as that mentioned above.

Therefore, I am formally requesting that the Kittitas County Board of Commissioners consider our situation, as well as my fortitude in requesting the information necessary for the application process, and waive the 60-day prior to event requirement.

In addition, I am respectfully requesting that waiver of the \$5,000 cash/bond that is requested per Kittitas County Code Chapter 5.20.100. As shared earlier in this writing, we are a volunteer-based non-profit organization, and do not have budgeted funds for this type of expense. Rest assured, we are going to have over 50 volunteers working to make sure that the Manastash Ridge hiking trail and it's surroundings are left in the same (if not even better) condition as prior to our event.

It is our goal to raise not only funds for Cancer Research, Advocacy, Education and Support Services for those touched by Cancer, but to help those in your community live healthier lives and enjoy More Birthdays.

Thank you for your understanding and support of this worthy cause, and I look forward to hearing from you.

Ray Pasture (up to 300) at 5450 Cove Rd.


