Request to Approve a Resolution awarding funding for grants pursuant to Law and Justice Council recommendations on spending of 1/10th of 1% sales tax reserves

BACKGROUND:

The Kittitas County Law and Justice Council was started in 1995 and is a requirement of state law, as declared in chapter 72.09 Revised Code of Washington. One of its functions is to make recommendations for funding of grants to meet the objectives of the council, aimed at reducing crime in our county or educating our citizens about law and justice concerns. These expenditures shall be made from the 1/10th of 1% sales tax reserve account established by the Board of County Commissioners for spending on special projects to foster cooperation, sharing of resources and enhancement of criminal justice projects within Kittitas County.
