1. Change Section 5.c., to read as follows:

. .

Prioritized Patient Categories

In accordance with SAPT Block Grant requirements, the County shall provide services under this Agreement giving preference as follows:

- (1) Pregnant injecting drug users
- (2) Pregnant substance abusers
- (3) Injecting drug users
- (4) Washington State defined priority populations; subsections (b) through (f) are in no particular order:
 - (a) Parenting women (first priority)
 - (b) Postpartum (up to one year, regardless of pregnancy outcome)
 - (c) Parenting individuals involved with Child Protective Services
 - (d) Youth
 - (e) Offenders (as defined in RCW 70.96A.350)
 - (f) Other Medicaid Clients
- (5) All others
- **2.** Remove Section 5.g. (2) (b) in its entirety.
- 3. Remove Section 5.g. (4) (b) in its entirety.
- 4. The Statement of work section is amended as follows:

A new subsection I, is added:

- Funding limitations for services to persons who are incarcerated:
 - (1) Medicaid funds: Medicaid funds shall not be used to provide services of any kind to persons incarcerated in a correctional setting, including but not limited to any correctional facility owned or operated by the state, county, or city.
 - (2) State Grant-in-Aid funds: Assessment services are the only services allowed to persons incarcerated.
- 5. Section 16, TARGET Requirements, Subsection d. (1) is changed to read as follows: Ensure that the date of first contact is entered into TARGET at least every seven (7) days.

- 6. Due to budget reductions, funds for the Children's Administration Chemical Dependency Professionals (CA-CDP) are decreased by \$207 in FY 10 and \$276 in FY 11.
- 7. The maximum consideration is decreased by \$2,282.65 to \$83,717.35. Funding changes in the following categories are identified on the new A&R, Exhibit A, attached:
