BACKGROUND: The Kittitas County Comprehensive Plan

(Specifically GPO 2.1) endeavors to maintain and enhance Kittitas County's natural resource industry base, including but not limited to productive agriculture resources. The County

has indentified that the acquisition of

conservation easements on working farms and

ranches is one method to support its agricultural industry base and ensure that agricultural lands are not converted to incompatible uses. In partnership with

Kittitas County, CLC has pursued and secured

grant awards under Federal and State

Farmland Preservation Programs for funding to the conserve the lands commonly known as the Triple Creek Ranch. Through this process,

CLC has incurred costs to facilitate the acquisition of a conservation easement. The

parties desire to establish an agreed

arrangement under which CLC will pursue and assist the County to pursue negotiation and acquisition of conservation easements on

Triple Creek Ranch.
