RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION 2004-36 AND GIVING GUIDANCE TO ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH REGARDING DETERMINATION RELATED TO POTABLE WATER SUPPLY

WHEREAS, Chapter 58.17 RCW requires that the County make a determination if an applicant seeking to divide land has made appropriate provisions for among other things potable water, and

WHEREAS, Section 58.17.150 RCW requires the local health department make a recommendation for each preliminary plat as to the adequacy of the proposed means of water supply, and

WHEREAS, Section 19.27.097 RCW requires applicants to provide evidence of an adequate water supply for the intended use of a building, and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2004-36 ratified an administrative policy that fails to provide Environmental Health with sufficient information to made the determinations they and the County are required to under State Law, and NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that:

The Resolution 2004-36 is rescinded and Environmental Health and Community

Development Services are instructed to require the submission by an applicant for a land division or building permit any information that their training and expertise lead them to believe necessary to make determinations and recommendations required by State Law or County Ordinance.
