port facilities in the state of Washington.

WHEREAS: The COG as directed, met on July 14, 2010, to review the

applications to consider if they met the economic

development needs of the county and communities within

the county; and

WHEREAS: The COG is presenting the results and their

recommendations for the funding as shown in Exhibit 'A';

and

WHEREAS: The 2011 Sales and Use Tax Funding will be available on

January 1, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Board of County Commissioners, after due consideration, does hereby accept the Conference of Government's recommendations to distribute the 2009 Sales and Use Tax for Public Facilities in Rural Counties in accordance with RCW 82.14.370 as shown in Exhibit 'A'.

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The Public Works Department will manage the Public Facilities Account.
