In response to your request, we have prepared this Additional Services Scope of Work and Fee Proposal.

Proposed Scope of Work:

The scope of work of this proposal includes replacing the existing 60 analog cameras, cabling, and video recording with a new I/P based video system components for the jail as an additive alternate bid. We propose to specify new network based I/P cameras, new signal and power-over-ethernet cabling, and new expanded digital video recording capacity to accommodate the replaced cameras. New monitors will be added to the central control room in the base bid in place of the existing analog monitors to provide increased surveillance. We also anticipate that we may have to modify the CCR console a bit to accommodate any new equipment. If necessary, this will be part of the base bid scope of work. We anticipate this additional work will cost between \$125,000 - \$130,000 including contractor's mark-ups.

Proposed Fee:

We propose to provide the Additional Services necessary for this alternate bid work for a lump sum fee of \$9,550. Our fee is broken down as follows:
