**Purpose:** In accordance with the original agreement, this grant is amended to revise the budget structure to combine Year 1 and Year 2 for greater flexibility for the Recipient.

- 1. This amendment is effective on July 1, 2011. The end date of the grant agreement remains June 30, 2014.
- 2. The following budget text on page 16 of the original grant agreement is deleted:
