5 **RESOLUTION DESIGNATING PERSONS TO ADMINISTER THE PROVISIONS OF**
6 **THE KITTITAS COUNTY CODE**

7 WHEREAS, Kittitas County Board of Health has determined it is necessary and in the
8 best interests of the county to enforce the provisions of the Kittitas County Code (KCC) , and
9

10 WHEREAS, The Kittitas County Code requires the Kittitas County Board of Health to
11 designate, by resolution, positions to administer the provisions of Title 18 KCC as to violations
12 of Titles 8 and 13 KCC as enforcement officers;

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following positions are designated as
14 authorized officials for the purposes of enforcing the Kittitas County Code as provided in KCC
15 18.01.020 (3) and are hereby empowered to do the same:

16 County Health Officer
17 Public Health Administrator
18 Environmental Health Supervisor
19 Community Health Services Supervisor
20 Health Promotions Manager
21 Environmental Health Specialist
22 Health Educator
23 Public Health Nurse

24 BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that such authorization shall continue for each individual for as long
25 as said individual maintains any of the positions with the Kittitas County Public Health
26 Department, unless the Kittitas County Board of Health provides otherwise by resolution.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any individual that is authorized to enforce Titles 8 and 13
28 KCC is also authorized to enforce all provisions of the Kittitas County Health Code, and that to

1 the same extent that this authorizes the Kittitas County Sheriff and his or her deputies, it also
2 authorizes members of local law enforcement within their respective jurisdictions.
