ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve Resolution declaring property surplus

BACKGROUND:

After proper notice, public hearing was held on January 21, 2009 to determine if a parking lot adjacent to 6th Street was surplus to the County's needs. The City of Ellensburg was proposing to exchange that property for vacating a portion of 6th Street and exchanging that with the County. The hearing was held, testimony taken, and inquiry into the public benefit conducted. The Hearing was continued to February 3, 2009 at which time the record was closed. The BOCC deliberated and voted unanimously to declare said property surplus.

INTERACTION:

The Prosecutor's Office, upon reviewing purchase and sale agreements contemplated to execute the above-described exchange, drafted a Resolution memorializing the BOCC 2009 decision of declaration of surplus.
