WHEREAS, Due to the excellent professional efforts of Rex Reed and his team the citizens of Kittitas County were always being updated with information, there was no loss of life or serious injuries and danger was held behind the lines; and

WHEREAS, Interaction with the Kittitas County Sheriff's Office Emergency Operating Center was continuous, courteous and compassionate during the entire time that Team Two was working the emergencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes Rex Reed and the DNR Team Two for all they have done for the citizens of Kittitas County and hereby Proclaims November 9, 2012 as "Rex Reed Day" and urges all citizens to say thank-you to any firefighter as a way to show their appreciation to Rex Reed.
