ACTION REQUESTED:

Request Boards approval for the Chair to sign the lease agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

BACKGROUND:

In July of 1962 the FAA entered in to an Easement agreement with the Department of Natural Resources for the construction, operation and maintenance of a microwave repeater at the Ryegrass Site.

In December of 1986 Kittitas County purchased the Section 16, Township 17, Range 21 from the Department of Natural Resources. The Quite Claim Deed lists the easement for the FAA.

In October of 1999 the lease with the FAA expired and it took until January 2003, to get a new lease agreement signed.

In October of 2009 the lease with the FAA expired again and the Prosecutors office and the Solid Waste office have been work to get a new lease agreement that all parties could agree to.
