Contract/Grant Summary: The Sheriff's Office and the U.S. Marshals Service have had a standing agreement regarding the housing of USMS detainees at Kittitas County Corrections Center since 2010. This serves as notice of the addition of restrictive housing requirements for USMS detainees. Restrictive housing is defined as any type of detention that involves all of the following three basic elements: removal from the general population, whether voluntary or involuntary; placement in a locked room or cell, whether alone or with another detainee; and the inability to leave the room or cell for the vast majority of the day, typically 22 hours or more.

Removal from the general population, whether voluntary or involuntary;

- Placement in a locked room or cell, whether alone or with another detainee; and
- Inability to leave the room or cell for the vast majority of the day, typically 22 hours or more.

For the purposes of this Agreement, "vulnerable population" means juveniles and individuals with serious mental illness.

The USMS Prisoner Operations Division has developed a web-based automated process for use by state, local, tribal, territorial and private detention service providers to report basic information regarding the use of restrictive housing for USMS prisoners. This information includes monthly use and duration of restrictive housing, and immediate notification whenever a member of a vulnerable population is housed restrictively.
