Kittitas County Code Chapter 5.20.100 (Penal Bond – Bond of Indemnity) states that no permit shall be issued until a deposit with the County Treasurer a \$5,000 cash or bond as an indemnity to save and protect the streets, etc. If you would like to request a waiver to this requirement, it must be put in writing to the Kittitas County Board of Commissioners along with reasons you believe a waiver should be granted.
