- (2) Recognizes and celebrates the important contributions that public works Professionals make every day to improve
 - (A) The public infrastructure of Kittitas County; and
 - (B) The communities that those professionals serve; and
- (3) Urges citizens and communities throughout Kittitas County to join with

County Government and the American Public Works
Association in paying tribute to the public works professionals
of Kittitas County and the Cities within Kittitas County; and

(4) Recognizes the substantial contributions that public works professionals make to the County, the State and the Nation.
