This Contract between the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) and the Contractor is hereby amended as follows:

1. Change Section 4.d., to read as follows:

Prioritized Patient Categories

In accordance with SAPT Block Grant requirements, the County shall provide services under this Agreement giving preference as follows:

- (1) Pregnant injecting drug users
- (2) Pregnant substance abusers
- (3) Injecting drug users
- (4) Washington State defined priority populations; subsections (b) through (f) are in no particular order:
 - (a) Parenting women (first priority)
 - (b) Postpartum (up to one year, regardless of pregnancy outcome)
 - (c) Parenting individuals involved with Child Protective Services
 - (d) Youth
 - (e) Offenders (as defined in RCW 70.96A.350)
 - (f) Other Medicaid Clients
- (5) All others
- **2.** Remove Section 4 i. (2) (b) in its entirety.
- 3. Remove Section 4. i. (4) (b) in its entirety.
- 4. Remove Section 4.m., Prevention Services, in its entirety.
- 5. The Specific Eligibility and/or Funding Requirements section is amended as follows:

A new subsection c. is added:

- c. Funding limitations for services to persons who are incarcerated:
 - (1) Medicaid funds: Medicaid funds shall not be used to provide services of any kind to persons incarcerated in a correctional setting, including but not limited to any correctional facility owned or operated by the state, county, or city.
 - (2) State Grant-in-Aid and CJTA funds: Assessment services are the only services allowed to persons incarcerated.

- 6. Under Consideration, a new Subsection f. (4), is added to the County Participation Match Requirement as follows:
 - <u>Local Cost Sharing Agreement</u>: Counties shall submit a completed Local Cost Sharing Agreement, along with the June monthly A19 Invoice Voucher, to their Regional Administrator annually.
- 7. Section 15, TARGET Requirements, Subsection d. (1) is changed to read as follows: Ensure that the date of first contact is entered into TARGET at least every seven (7) days.
- 8. Due to budget reductions, funds for the Children's Administration Chemical Dependency Professionals (CA-CDP) are decreased by \$207 in FY 10 and \$276 in FY 11.
- 9. Pacific County is deleted from Section 3 of Exhibit C, CA-CDP Program Standards and Guidelines.
- **10.** The maximum consideration is decreased by \$9,659 to \$707,443. Funding changes in the following categories are identified on the new A&R, Exhibit A, attached:

Disability Lifeline, State GIA

FY 2010:

CA - CDP

All other terms and conditions of this Contract remain in full force and effect.

County participation match programs include State Grant-in-Aid, Federal SAPT Grant-in-Aid and CITA.

<u>Criminal Justice Treatment Account</u>

Criminal Justice Treatment Account (CJTA) funds are awarded to counties by state fiscal year in accordance with OFM budget allotment distribution. However, CJTA funds are legislatively appropriated on a biennial basis.

No more than 10% of the CJTA and Drug Court award may be spent on BARS 566.11 for County Only Administration. No more than 10% of the CJTA and Drug Court award may be spent on BARS 566.11 for Drug Court Administration.

SAPT Grant-in-Aid

Substance Abuse Prevention/Treatment (SAPT) Block Grant funds are awarded to counties by state fiscal year in accordance with OFM budget allotment distribution. However, the federal SAPT block grant award(s) state:

FFY 2009 Award: Funds awarded under this grant must be expended by September 30, 2011.

FFY 2010 Award: Funds awarded under this grant must be expended by September 30, 2012.
