Claim of Jack Leeper

Incident date Apr 5 2011

Kittitas county road personnel where performing snow removal operations in the Hyak estates area. Equipment operator ( Rob Fudacz ) was operating snow blower #506 in the area of Mr. Leeper residents. Under normal operation this machine can place discharged snow any where in a 280 degree area. However during this period the discharge shoot was limited to 90 degrees right or left only due to brake downs. Mr. Fudacz stated he was unaware of any snow hitting Mr Lenny's residents however given the height of the snow banks and the limitation of the snow blower it was possible. Kittitas county employee Wes Willette went to Mr. Lenny's home on Monday Apr 11 2011 to investigate damage. Mr Willette reported new boards have been installed and there was signs of damage. At this time all snow has been removed.
