ACTION REQUESTED: Authorize course registration reimbursement for Linda Navarre, Community Health Services Supervisor, to attend the Epidemiology and Prevention of Vaccine-Preventable Diseases Center for Disease Control sponsored training in Tacoma, WA.

BACKGROUND: An advanced training course for Healthcare professionals who provide immunizations is offered by the Center for Disease Control (CDC). This course will provide continuing education credits, a requirement for sustainment of staff member's registered nursing license and the health department's immunization program requirement for continuing education. Staff member will apply for a scholarship, if available, to support the cost of this educational opportunity.

This course, presented by the faculty from the CDC's National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases, will present a live 2-day comprehensive overview of the principles of vaccination, general recommendations, and immunization strategies for providers, and specific information about vaccine-preventable diseases and the vaccines that prevent them.
