ACTION REQUESTED:

Request BOCC approve and adopt by Resolution recommended by-laws changes to the Mission Statement and By-Laws of the Kittitas County Law and Justice Council.

BACKGROUND:

KCLAJC members reviewed by-laws for needed membership changes and voting requirements in the LAJC's Mission Statement and By-Laws. As the LAJC is an advisory body to the BOCC by state law and the BOCC approves the LAJC by-laws the proposed changes are presented for the BOCC's review and approval for final adoption.

INTERACTION:

The LAJC followed its current by-laws in reviewing and voting to recommend approval of the changes. The Prosecuting Attorney granted his approval to move forward with the Resolution. The changes, the Resolution, the minutes indicating process and a final draft of amended by-laws were prepared and are offered for the BOCC's review.
