**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Consider claim against County by Marc Eylar.

**BACKGROUND:**

Mr. Eylar had som personal property that he left over night in a County Noxious Weed Board truck. The truck was parked in a County Public Works lot, was broken into during the night, and the personal property was stolen. Mr. Eylar filed a claim in the amount of \$120 for the loss of this stole property with the Auditor on 8//30/11.

**INTERACTION:**

The Auditor forwarded the claim to the Prosecutor's office who sought, and orally received, input from the Public Works Director and Noxious Weed Program Coordinator.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Deny the claim. The County is not responsible for guarantying the safety of people's personal property that they chose to bring to work and leave on/in County facilities.
