SPECIAL MEETING WATER AND CISTERN CODE DISCUSSION COMMISSIONERS

At 10:00 a.m. Chairman Jewell opened a Special Meeting to discuss the Water and Cistern Code as it is being developed.

The Board and staff discussed definitions in Ch.13.03; Ch. 13.20 Well Construction; 13.25 Cisterns System Requirements; Ch. 13.35 Adequate Water Supply Determination and Ch. 13.80 Appeals.

Dr. Larsen expressed some concerns with looser regulations for selfhauling of water as opposed to licensed water purveyors. He said the worrisome part was there was no teeth to the requirements to hold people accountable.

It was decided to have appeals heard administratively. Notice of Violation appeals would go before the Hearings Examiner with Health Order appeals before the Board of Health.

Deputy Prosecutor Becker said the SEPA review documents will be ready by April 5, 2011 and the code will be considered during a public hearing in June.
