ACTION REQUESTED:

Conduct closed record meeting to consider the Aspen Grove Preliminary Plat (LP-10-04).

BACKGROUND:

Brookside Consulting, agent for property owner Saddle Ridge LLC have applied for a 7-lot preliminary plat on approximately 21 acres of land that is zoned Rural-3. The project is proposed to be served by a Group B water system and individual on-site septic systems.

The subject property is located approximately 4 miles west of the city of Cle Elum, south of Misty Mountain Way and west of Big Horn Way, Cle Elum, WA in a portion of Section 33, T20N, R14E, WM, in Kittitas County. Assessor's map number: 20-14-33000-0009.

On August 16, 2011 the Board of County Commissioner's conducted a closed record meeting to consider the Hearing Examiner's recommendation on the Vista West Performance Based Cluster Plat (CL-09-01), the Tamarack Valley Rezone (RZ-10-04) and Preliminary Plat (LP-10-03) and the Aspen Grove Preliminary Plat (LP-10-04). The Board came to the consensus to discuss the three applications together since there seemed to be the same issues surrounding them all.

It was moved and seconded to remand the three applications back to the Hearing Examiner to conduct an open record hearing to consider 1) cumulative impacts from the three applications before making his decision, 2) the total combined number of lots, 3) the Long Range Transportation Plan, 4) secondary access, and, 5) the requirements of the International Fire Code.

The Hearing Examiner conducted an open record hearing on October 27, 2011 to consider the remand issues where testimony was heard. On November 10, 2011 the Hearing Examiner issued a recommendation of approval for the Aspen Grove Preliminary Plat (LP-10-04).

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Board conduct the closed record meeting as scheduled to consider the Hearing Examiner's recommendation for the Aspen Grove Preliminary Plat (LP-10-04) and direct staff to prepare enabling documents based upon the decision of the Board.
