ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve a Request for Qualifications for Airport Engineering Services for the 2012 Apron Maintenance/Rehabilitation Project at Bowers Field.

BACKGROUND:

With the Airfield Needs Assessment nearing completion we have a very close to final "draft" Capital Improvement Plan. In this plan, for year 2013 projects is this Apron Maintenance/Rehab project. This project will be funded 95% by FAA-Airport Improvement Plan funding and 5% local match. The airport intends to apply to WSDOT-Aviation for funding in the spring for 2.5% of the 5% local match. This project will be focused on the tie-down apron only. It will include construction of some new pavement, removal of old and placement of new tiedowns, addition of two more business jet tie-down locations, crackfill-slurry seal and re-stripe the area. June 2012 is the target to begin construction.
