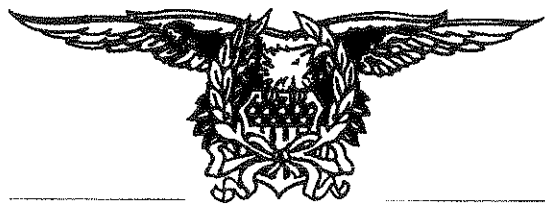
Itinerary for ABATE of Washington Spring Opener 2012

Security

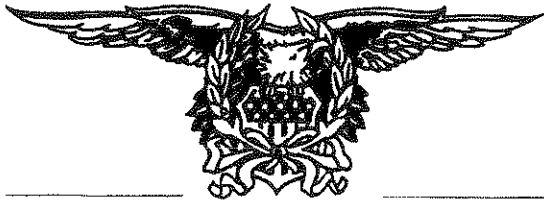

Arm bands will be given to identify that patrons are over 21 and belong in event.

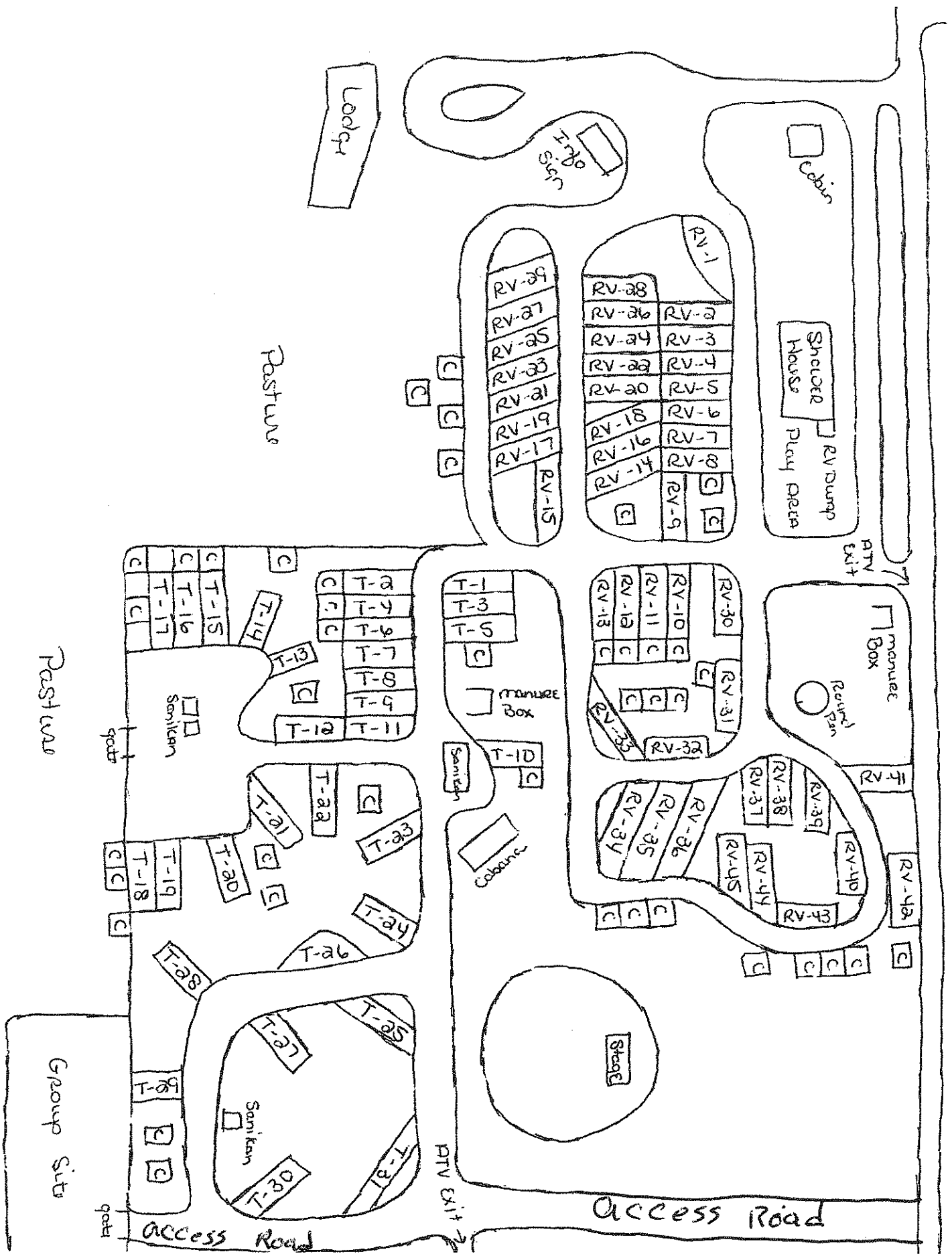
3. Coordinate Sheriffs Department Coordination of Kit-Com and Phoenix Security.
