This Treatment Agreement between Kittitas County and Alcohol Drug Dependency Services is here by amended as follows:

- 1. A portion of State Grant-in-Aid funds for Fiscal Year 2011 are substituted with Title 19/Medicaid funds (a net zero result). A line item for Title 19/Medicaid, CFDA# 93.778, is added to the A&R, Exhibit A.
- 2. An allowable amount of Criminal Justice Treatment Account funds from Fiscal Year 2010 (\$28,652.00) are rolled-over to Fiscal Year 2011.
- 3. Due to underutilization by CRRC, FY 11 State Grant-in-Aid funding has been increased by \$13,000.00. State GIA for Direct Billing is increased by \$8,000.00 and State GIA Title 19 Match has been increased by \$5,000.00.
- 4. The maximum consideration for the entire contract has been increased by \$13,000.00 to \$636,725.65. All funding changes described above are identified on the attached A&R, Exhibit A
