## Debbie --

Per the recent article I sent you recently from the June MRSC Insight: Local Government, regarding the hotel-motel tax alert, here is what I conclude in relation to the Kittitas Valley Junior Soccer Association:

- The funds appear to be granted for the outdoor soccer tournament "operation," or support of operations and capital expenditures of tourism-related facilities owned by a non-profit organization.
- Per RCW 67.28.1816, there is a reporting requirement to the legislature for expanded uses under the law. The expanded uses allowed hotel-motel tax funds to be used for "operation" as opposed to "marketing" of special events and/or festivals designed to attract tourists, and for support of the operations and capital expenditures of tourism-related facilities owned by non-profit organizations. Reporting under this law was to begin with calendar year 2008.
- However, the section allowing these kinds of expenditures will expire June 30, 2013, unless changed or extended by the legislature. At this time it is unknown whether the legislature will extend the sunset date. Therefore there is a risk that any funds paid by the county from the hotel-motel tax account, which are paid after June 30, 2013, would run afoul of the law.
- In order to avoid the possibility of an illegal award, I suggest the board modify its award and previous agreement with the KVJSA. I will forward an amendment for the board's consideration.
- That way, the County is assured that the expenditures will be completed by June 30, 2013 in order to comply with the law.
- If the legislature should act during or before the first quarter of 2013 to extend the deadline, then the board could revisit the contract and make another amendment allowing the KVJSA a few additional months in which to allocate their reimbursable expenses.
