**AGENDA DATE:** August 21, 2012

**ACTION REQUESTED:** Schedule a public hearing on September 18, 2012 to consider updating the Kittitas County Code Chapter 10.12.010 Stops and Yields designated for White Pine Drive and Red Cedar Drive.

**BACKGROUND:** The Board of County Commissioners accepted Evergreen Valley subdivision roads including White Pine Drive and Red Cedar Drive onto the County Road Maintenance System on August 17, 2004. The Commissioners held a public hearing on July 15, 2008 to consider establishing stop signs in this subdivision. At the 2008 public hearing, the Commissioners determined that a stop sign was not needed at the intersection of White Pine Drive and Red Cedar Drive until Red Cedar Drive was extended southeasterly to join with Tamarack Drive. These roads are now fully constructed and link together. The resident at 102 Red Cedar Drive has requested that the County consider placing stop signs at this intersection.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Set a public hearing to consider placing a stop sign on White Pine Drive at the intersection with Red Cedar Drive.

**HANDLING:** Return one signed copy of Notice of Public Hearing to Public Works
