WHEREAS, RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, provides the capability for public agencies to cooperate by providing services and facilities for mutual advantage; and

WHEREAS, Kittitas County, through the Kittitas County Sheriff's Office, is charged with keeping and preserving the peace and apprehending or securing any person for felony or breach of the peace; and

WHEREAS, The Washington State Department of Corrections is authorized per RCW 72.68.040 to contract with any county in the State to provide for the detention in an institution or jail for prisoners convicted of a felony and sentenced to a term of imprisonment; and

WHEREAS, The Kittitas County Sheriff's Office and the Washington State Department of Corrections wish to contract for the purposes of maximizing the efficient and cost effective use of existing resources and to provide adequate facilities and programs for the confinement, care, and treatment of offenders under the jurisdiction of the Washington State Department of Corrections; and

WHEREAS, All parties have agreed to enter into such an agreement under the terms and conditions of the Interlocal Agreement shown on and attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners authorized the execution of this Interagency Agreement by action taken at a regular meeting; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Kittitas County, Washington authorizes the Sheriff of Kittitas County to execute the Interagency Agreement with the Washington State Department of Corrections that is attached hereto, and incorporated herein by this reference.
