which are defined as bridges, roads, domestic and industrial water facilities, sanitary sewer facilities, earth stabilization, storm sewer facilities, railroad, electricity, natural gas, buildings, structures, telecommunications infrastructure, transportation infrastructure or commercial infrastructure and

port facilities in the state of Washington.

WHEREAS: The COG as directed, met on July 20, 2011, to review the

applications to consider if they met the economic

development needs of the county and communities within

the county; and

WHEREAS: The COG is presenting the results and their

recommendations for the funding as shown in Exhibit 'A';

and

WHEREAS: The 2012 Sales and Use Tax Funding will be available on

January 1, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Board of County Commissioners, after due consideration, does hereby accept the Conference of Government's recommendations to distribute the 2012 Sales and Use Tax for Public Facilities in Rural Counties in accordance with RCW 82.14.370 as shown in Exhibit 'A'.

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The Public Works Department will manage the Public Facilities Account.

The Conference of Governments (COG) convened on July 20, 2011, to consider the merits of funding of three (3) applications competing for approximately \$250,000 of Distressed County Sales & Use Tax for the purpose of improving a community's infrastructure in hopes of creating a more positive economic development climate. The table reflects the project name, the amount requested and the COG recommended funding.

The COG reviewed all the applications and applauds each applicant for the thoroughness of each of the submittals. Since not every project was funded fully, the list represents what the COG felt would have immediate economic impact on the individual communities. The COG took the position that once these funds were expended there should be a tangible project that either immediately improves economic development or provides a design that leads to construction. These projects are worthy candidates for economic development dollars but the application and project scope need to lead to a completed project.

Copies of the applications are attached along with the final score sheet with recommended funding priorities. Thank you for the opportunity to play a critical role in the evaluation and application of funds that will assist in improving the economic development picture for the entire Kittitas Valley community and we recommend you approve the funded projects as submitted.
