ACTION REQUESTED:

Request to approve the Washington State Patrol Live-Scan to Automated Fingerprint Identification System Connection User's Agreement between WSP and Kittitas County Sheriff's Office.

BACKGROUND:

This agreement is between Washington State Patrol (WSP) and the Kittitas County Sheriff's Office. WSP is an agency of the State of Washington authorized by law to establish and operate an "AFIS" automated fingerprint identification system. The Kittitas County Sheriff's Office will operate live-scan fingerprinting equipment to capture fingerprint images and related information of a person arrested, registered as a sex or kidnapping offender, or apply for licensing or employment pursuant to state or local requirements.
